Other Festivals/Events:

During significant festivals and public holidays in Singapore, such as Chinese New Year and National Day, there are often large crowds and road closures that can impact traffic and pedestrian areas. Key points to consider include:

- Chinese New Year (Sat, 10 Feb 2024 – Sun, 11 Feb 2024):**
This festival typically sees bustling activities in various parts of the city, especially in Chinatown. Streets may be closed for festive markets and parades, leading to increased pedestrian traffic and potential disruptions to vehicular movement.
- National Day (9th August but road closures may commence prior):**
Celebrated on August 9th, National Day is marked by grand festivities, including the National Day Parade. Areas around the Marina Bay, particularly near the Fullerton Hotel, often experience road closures and heavy pedestrian traffic. The Fullerton area, being a prime spot for viewing fireworks and parade activities, becomes especially crowded.

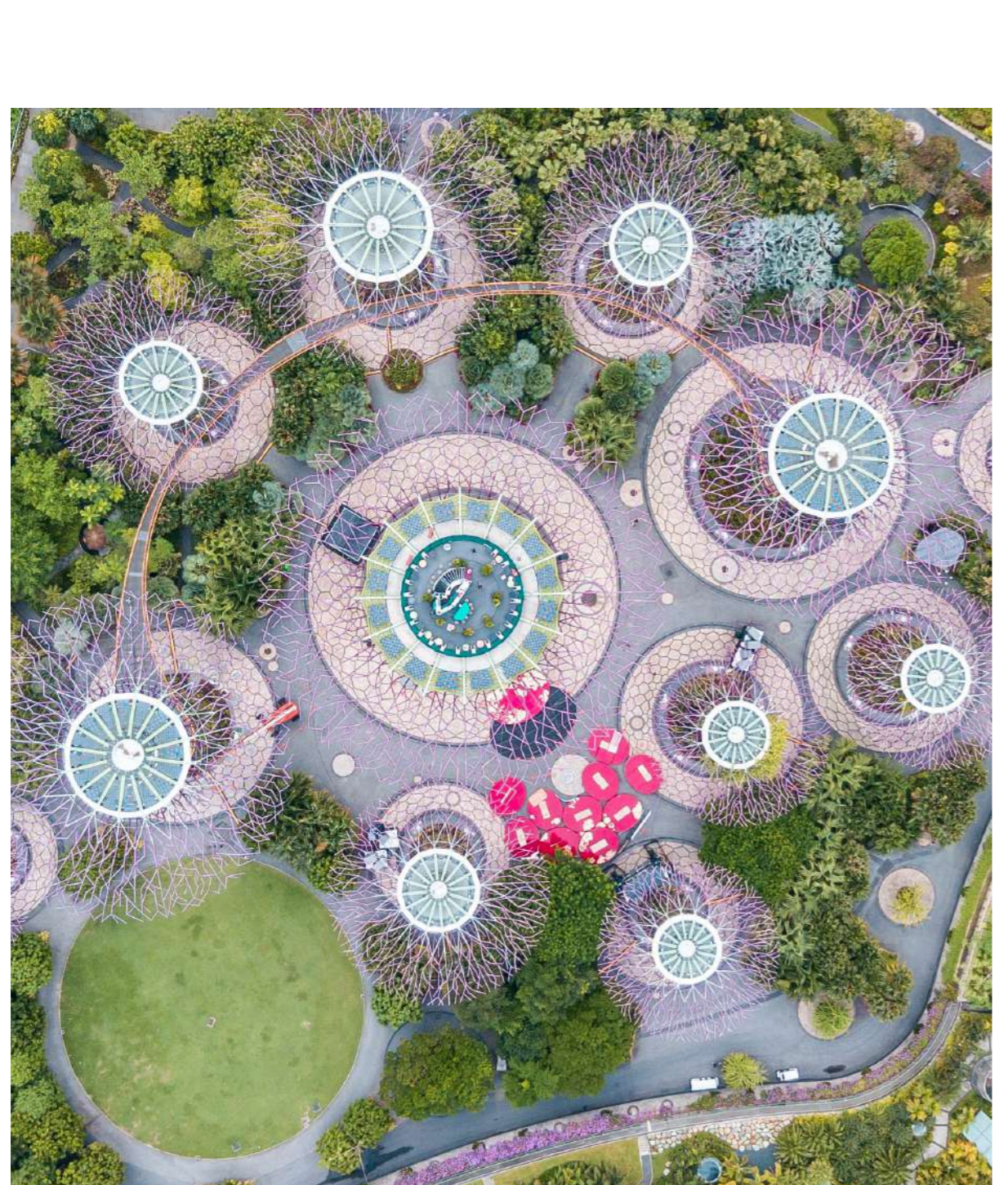


- Traffic and Accessibility:**
During these events, certain roads may be closed for parades or festivities, affecting both vehicular and pedestrian traffic. It's advisable to plan ahead, considering public transport options or alternative routes.
- Crowd Management:**
These events attract large crowds, so it's important to be mindful of personal safety and belongings. Authorities usually implement crowd control measures, but it's still advisable to be cautious, especially in tightly packed areas.

Weather Guide Through the Year

Singapore has a tropical rainforest climate that is generally hot and humid, with temperatures averaging between 25°C and 31°C throughout the year.

Rainfall is fairly evenly distributed throughout the year, but the monsoon seasons typically occur from **November to January** and from **June to July**.



- Tips and Tricks:**
- Avoid Peak Hours:**
For a more comfortable travel experience, avoid public transport during peak hours (7-9 AM and 6-8 PM).
- Useful Apps:**
Apps like Google Maps, Grab (Singapore's version of Uber), Foodpanda or Deliveroo (for food delivery, although certain hotels might not allow the delivery of food from outside the hotel) and the Visit Singapore app (Singapore's official tourism app) can be handy for navigation and information.
- Language:**
While English is widely spoken, learning a few phrases in Mandarin, Malay, or Tamil can be appreciated and useful in local neighbourhoods.
- Hawker Centres:**
For an authentic and affordable dining experience, suggest visiting hawker centres like Lau Pa Sat at night and Maxwell Road Food Centre in the day.
