
1715 - 1815 hours: We take MRT to the Marina Barrage, Singapore's 15th reservoir, located in the heart of the



have photovoltaic cells on their canopies to harvest solar energy for lighting up the Supertrees, while others are integrated with the Conservatories and serve as air exhaust receptacles. Your guide will share the Lake System which comprises of two lakes – the Dragonfly Lake and Kingfisher Lake. The Gardens lake system incorporates key ecological processes and functions as a living system. It acts as a natural filtration system for water from the Gardens catchment and provides aquatic habitats for biodiversity such as fishes and dragonflies. Finally, you'll be dropped off at the architecturally distinctive Conservatories to explore at you own leisure (entrance cost at own expenses). Comprising two glass biomes, the Conservatories replicate the cool-dry climate of the Mediterranean and semi-arid sub-tropical regios and the cool-moist climate of the Tropical Montane region. They house a diverse collection of plants that are not commonly seen in this part of the word.
